
Comparison of Current and Proposed By-Law Standards for Wall Signs in Special Sign Districts




Maximum Wall Sign Area Current By-law Standard (Narrow Storefront)



Maximum Wall Sign Area Proposed By-law Standard (Narrow Storefront)




Maximum Wall Sign Area Current By-law Standard (Wide Storefront)





BY-LAW 2007-XXX

A by-law to amend Sign By-law 2002-94

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MARKHAM HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. By-law 2002-94 is hereby amended as it applies to wall signs in Special Sign Districts, Section 10.3, Table E:
 - a) By deleting the following text under the Maximum Area column for wall signs:
 - "0.25m² per 1.0m of building façade to a maximum of 2.25m²"
 - b) By adding the following text under the Maximum Area column for wall signs:
 - "0.30m² per 1.0m of building façade, to a maximum of 5.0m² (Except for Main Street, Unionville)
 0.25m² per 1.0m of building façade to a maximum of 2.25m² (Main Street Unionville only)"
- 2. All other provisions of Sign By-law 2002-94, not inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law shall continue to apply.

By-law to amend Sign By-law 2002-94 as it pertains to the maximum allowable area of wall signs in Special Sign Districts.

The purpose of this By-law is to amend the Sign By-law to change the maximum allowable area of wall signs in Special Sign Districts, except for properties located on Main Street Unionville.

The effect of this By-law will allow for a modest increase in the maximum area of wall signs in Special Sign Districts, except for properties located on Main Street Unionville, where the standards under By-law 2002-94 shall continue to apply.
