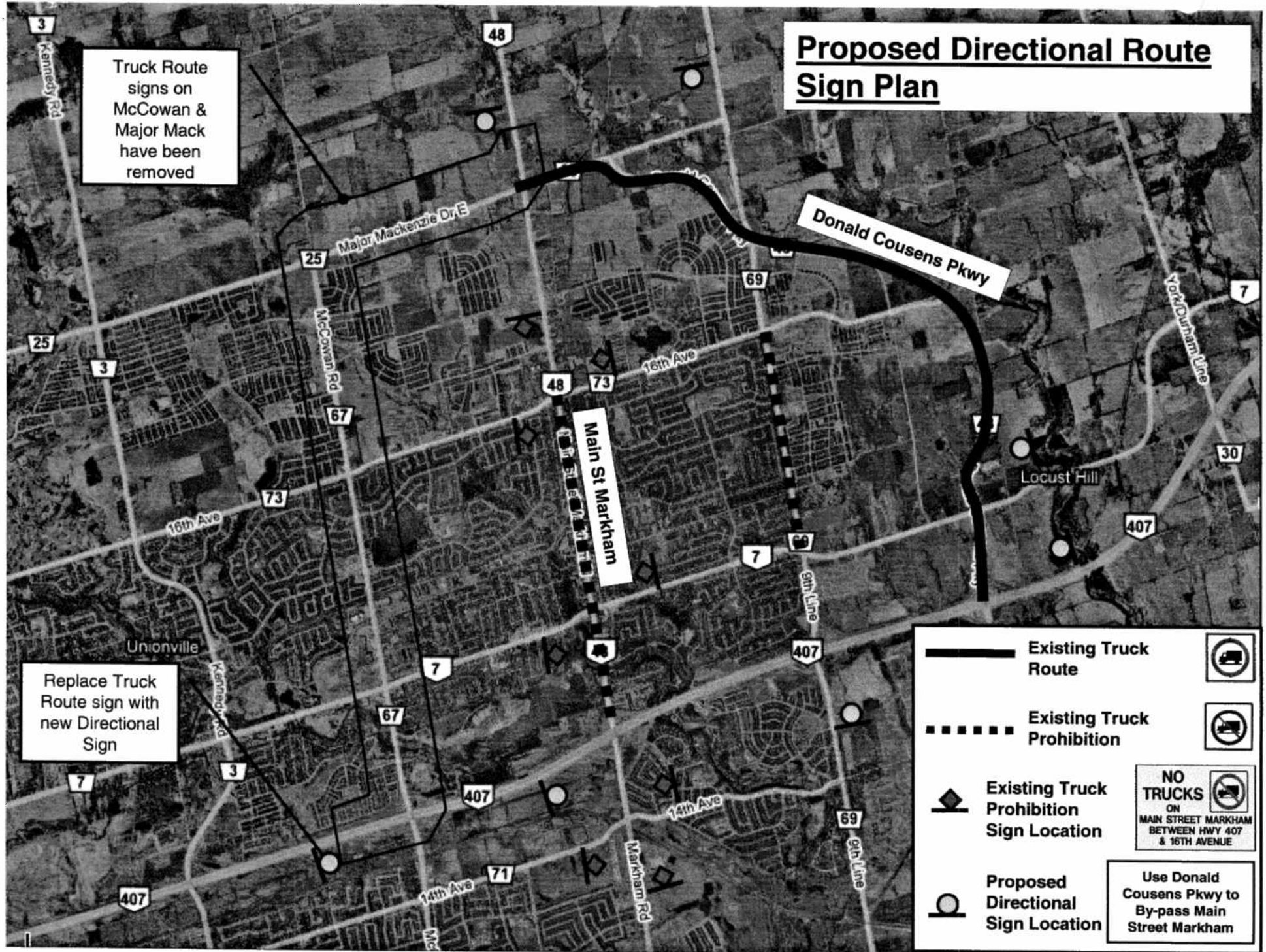
Presentation Purpose

- As per Council's resolution on March 4, 2008, the Engineering Department is reporting back on the final directional route sign plan for non-local traffic in Markham's east end, including:
 - McCowan Road
 - Donald Cousens Parkway
 - Highway 407

Next Steps

- York Region, in coordination with 407 ETR to implement the revised sign plan:
 - York Region to cover sign costs and installation on Regional Roads
 - Markham to cover sign costs installed on Highway 407
 - Approximately \$15,000 for the revised highway signs
 - Funding available under the Engineering Department 2008 Project #8402
 - Both York Region and Highway 407 to install revised signage by July 2008
