

#### **Growth Forecasts**

- Accommodates forecast growth for Markham to 2031
- Increase of 151,000 residents & 96,000 jobs

### **Housing Stock**

- Maintains a mix of housing choices to 2031
- Contributes to intensification objectives





# Preferred Growth Alternative to 2031

### **Employment**

- Employment intensification supporting transit
- Maintains long term competitive choices to accommodate employment growth

#### **Live-Work**

• Provides for housing mix and jobs supportive of improved live-work opportunities within the Town.

#### **Environment**

• Implements a Town Greenway System and provides an enhanced environment for agriculture.



#### **Sustainable Communities**

• Will include new, sustainable communities, leading the GTA in water and energy management, wellness, accessibility, biodiversity, equity and choice


