### Request from YRDSB

- YRDSB currently only maintains one pool in entire York Region Thornlea Pool
- Has requested Town of Markham to consider assuming full maintenance operations of Thornlea Pool, adjacent to Thornlea Secondary School



## **Original Agreement**

- Agreement made in 1971
- YRDSB sold land to Town of Markham for \$1.00
- Town of Markham paid all construction costs for construction of a small facility including 25 metre, 6 lane pool and single gymnasium
- YRDSB performs all maintenance and assumes all facility related costs, then bills Town of Markham



## **Original Agreement**

- > YRDSB has use Monday to Friday from 9:00 am to 5:30 pm
- Town of Markham has use Monday to Friday from 6:00 pm to 11 pm
- Town of Markham has use Saturdays from 8:30 am to 11pm and Sundays from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm
- Town of Markham has use during all School Break Periods, Monday to Saturday from 8:30 am to 11 pm and Sundays from 10 am to 5 pm
- During years of operation Town of Markham has assumed more hours of operation beginning earlier in the evenings and offering early morning programs



## **Original Agreement**

- Town of Markham has use of facility 64.62% of the original allotted time
- > YRDSB has use of facility 35.38% of the original allotted time
- Town of Markham pays YRDSB 64.62% of all associated operating and capital costs
- YRDSB covers the remaining 35,38% of all remaining operating and capital costs
- Town of Markham continues to pay 64.62% of all associated operating and capital costs, though currently uses closer to 70% of the available time.



#### **Financial Considerations**

YRDSB currently operates on a fiscal year of Sept 1 through Aug 31. In the fiscal year ending Aug 31, 2007 the Town of Markham was billed \$323,832.51 as follows:

Item	Cost
1. Utilities	\$154,102.56
2. Supplies	\$18,805.20
3. Maintenance (including capital)	\$175,782.42
4. Salaries & Benefits	\$143,986.92
5. Miscellaneous	\$8,456.47
TOTAL	\$501,133.57
64.62% Billed to Town of Markham	\$323.832.51
35.38% Paid by YRDSB	\$177,301.06

The Town of Markham is in a position of risk as it has no jurisdiction in how the facility is maintained but then must contribute 64.62% of all costs.



#### **Financial Considerations**

The Town of Markham assumes to a total operating deficit of \$309,882 (excluding any capital expenses) annually as highlighted in the table below:

Personnel Expenses	\$391,386
Non Personnel Expenses	\$277,172
Total Expenses	\$668,558
Total Revenue	(\$358,676)
NET	\$309,882

<sup>\* \$240,000</sup> of Non personnel expenses are paid to YRDSB for operating costs, excluding capital.

It is believed that by through efficiencies of operating multiple pools and lower wage structure, the Town of Markham could assume operations with YRDSB has a major tenant without impacting current net operating deficit

#### Recommendations

- THAT Council support taking over maintenance and operations of the Thornlea Pool Facility conditional upon further negotiations with YRDSB
- THAT Staff be directed to undertake negotiations with YRDSB in taking over maintenance and operations of Thornlea Pool Facility such that YRDSB are a major rental tenant of the facility contributing revenue equal to or greater than current financial contribution to the facility and that a Capital Surcharge be negotiated for YRDSB to pay annually to offset assumed capital costs to the facility
- That staff report back results of negotiations prior to any formal agreement being made
