# **Presentation Synopsis**

## Ontario Municipal Management Institute

A non-profit association established in 1979 by; Ontario's local and provincial governments, Associations, the Provincial Government, and educational institutions:

"to promote management development through recognition and training of local government staff, supervisors and managers"

The Certified Municipal Manager Accreditation Program:

"Recognizes education and employment experience, with four levels of the CMM designation, while providing a personal development analysis with a guiding framework, to encourage broadening a member's career development".

In June 1988, the passage in the Ontario Legislature of Bill PR27, accorded full legal status and recognition to the CMM Accreditation. The current membership of over sixteen hundred; includes thirty professions in the local government sector, from front staff to senior management.



A number of recent, expanded partnerships, with the supporting associations (above), provide opportunities for <u>profession-specific</u> "enhancements" to the CMM. These, new Supplemental Accreditations, help our partners address the accreditation needs of <u>their</u> members.

## Ontario Municipal Fire Prevention Officers Association

With over 600 members, from over 200 different Fire Departments and Fire Service related companies, throughout the Province of Ontario, the association plays a key role in promoting fire prevention and fire safety education initiatives on both provincial and federal levels.

The organization started from a need to share knowledge among peers and has grown into a group that is regularly consulted on new directions in fire prevention. It regularly calls upon the members to represent the group and provide input into the development of codes, standards and other relevant pieces of legislation.

The Fire Prevention "enhancement" of the CMM was officially introduced in June, 2006 at the OMFPOA Spring Conference in Barrie. This initiative addresses the career development and recognition needs of their members, providing a profession-specific credential. All recipients of this designation have successfully met both the expanded education and job responsibility requirements, in the area of Fire Prevention, as determined by the OMFPOA.
