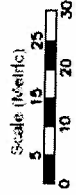
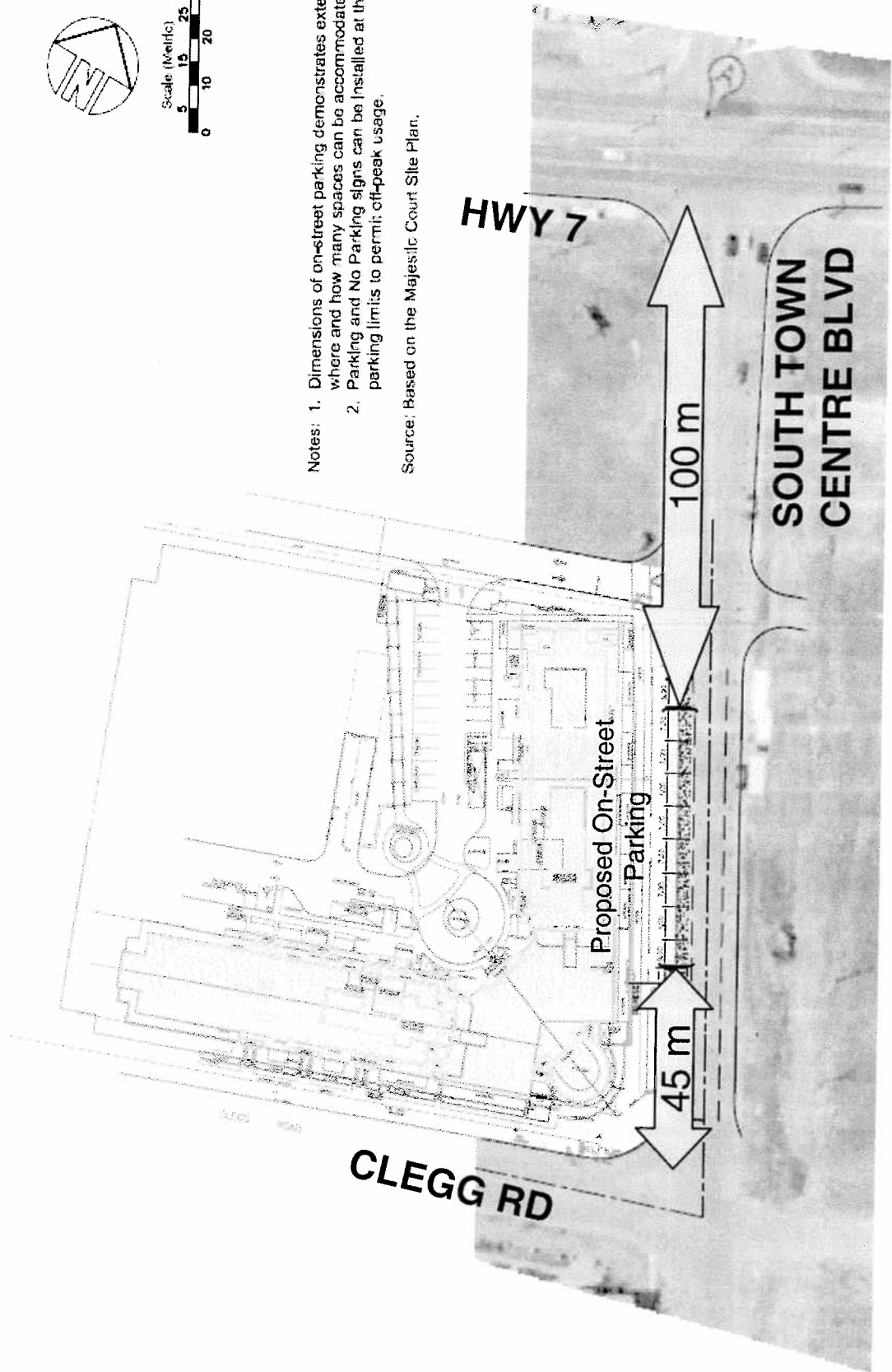

BY-LAW NUMBER _____

TO AMEND PARKING BY-LAW 2005-188

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MARKHAM THAT Parking By-Law 2005-188 be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

1. That Schedule "C" of Parking By-law 2005-188, pertaining to "No Parking", be amended by deleting the following:

3. That Schedule "L" of Parking By-law 2005-188, pertaining to "Parking Machine Control Areas", be amended by adding the following:

4. The By-law shall come into force and effect upon receiving the third reading by the Council of the Town of Markham and also when authorized signs have been erected.
