1. WATER SYSTEM MANAGEMENT COUNCIL WORKSHOP, PRESENTATION # 3

Robert Muir, Senior Stormwater Management Engineer gave a presentation on Water System Management - Stormwater Strategy and Funding.

Discussions included a Special Policy Area for the flood-prone area of Thornhill, water consumption, calculation of rates, funding options, flood proofing, standards for new developments, Don Mills Channel, climate change impacts, the status of the stormwater feasibility/utility study, permeable paving, potential damage to public properties as well as private properties.

Options were reviewed with respect to time frames for Local Improvements, and property values of improved properties were questioned. Staff will provide updates on these matters and a further discussion will be scheduled with Council before proceeding to the public.

Next steps include a public information process on Flood Control Strategy and referred funding option; a report to General Committee and Council; followed by implementation of flood control fee and tax rate (2013-2014) to support 2014 construction. Staff recommend a funding resolution be determined by the end of 2012.

The Committee thanked staff for their work on this project.
